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# Network Components at a Glance

- Device drivers: vioif, vmx, wm, ixg, ixv, etc.
- Layer 2: Ethernet, bridge, ATM, FDDI, Firewire, IEEE 802.11, etc.
- Layer 3: IPv4/ICMP/ARP, IPv6/ICMPv6/ND, MPLS, etc.
- Layer 4+: TCP, UDP, DCCP, SCTP, socket, PCB, etc.
- Pseudo I/Fs: gif, l2tp, pppoe, tun, ppp, agr, carp, gre, tap, vlan, etc.
- Packet filters: npf, ipf, pf
- Others: ifnet, bpf, pfil, ipsec, altq, NFS, CIFS, openssl, etc.

# How to try

- Disabled by default in -current yet
  - The big lock(s) remain
- Enabled by `NET_MPSAFE` kernel option
- Recommended setups
  - Router
    - IPv4/IPv6 forwarding
    - npf
  - Intel 1/10 Gbps NICs
